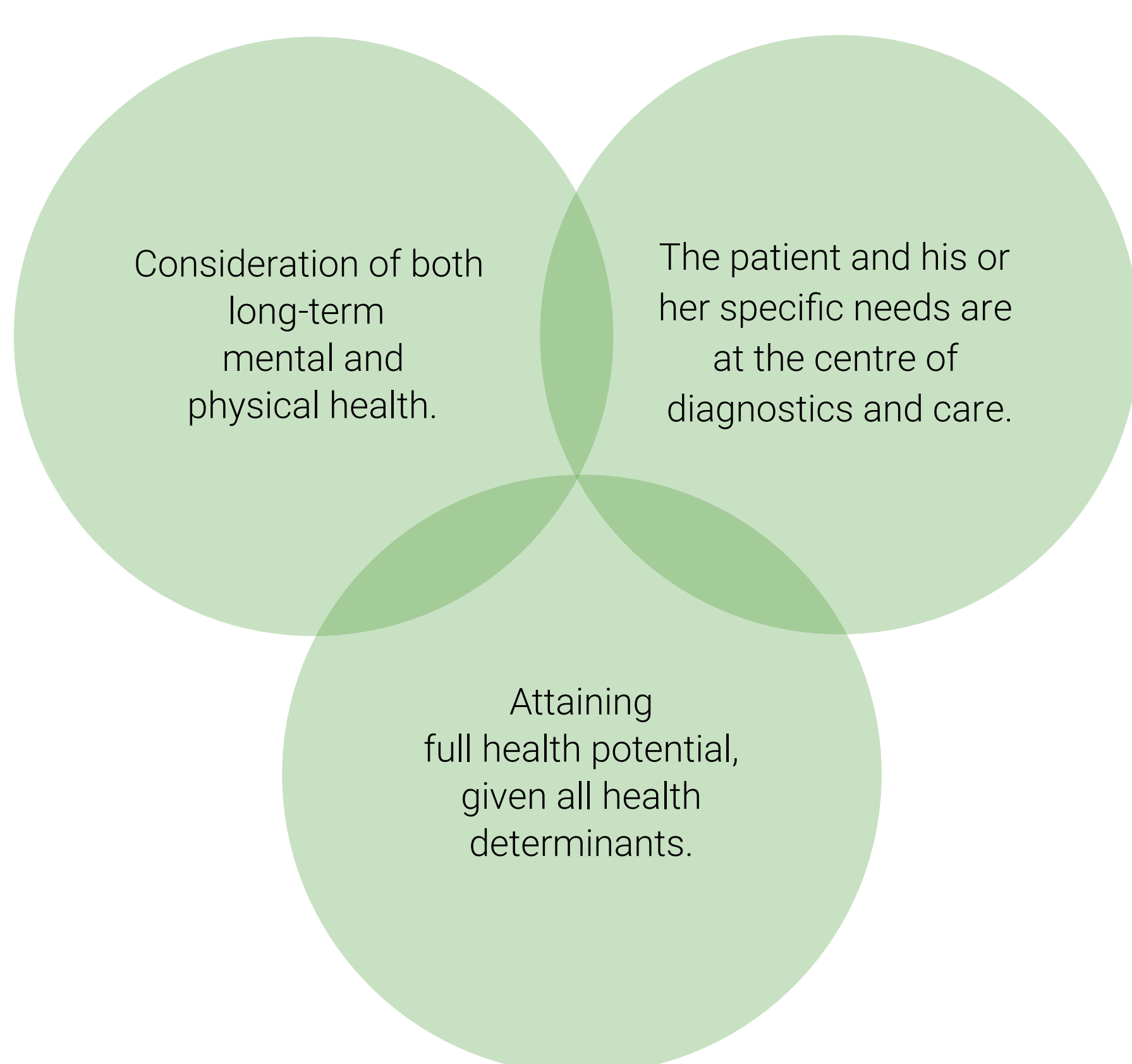

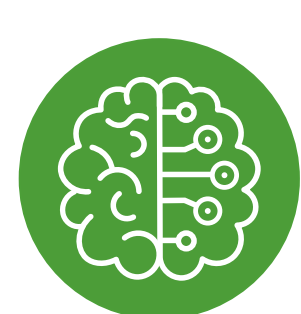

### Glocal

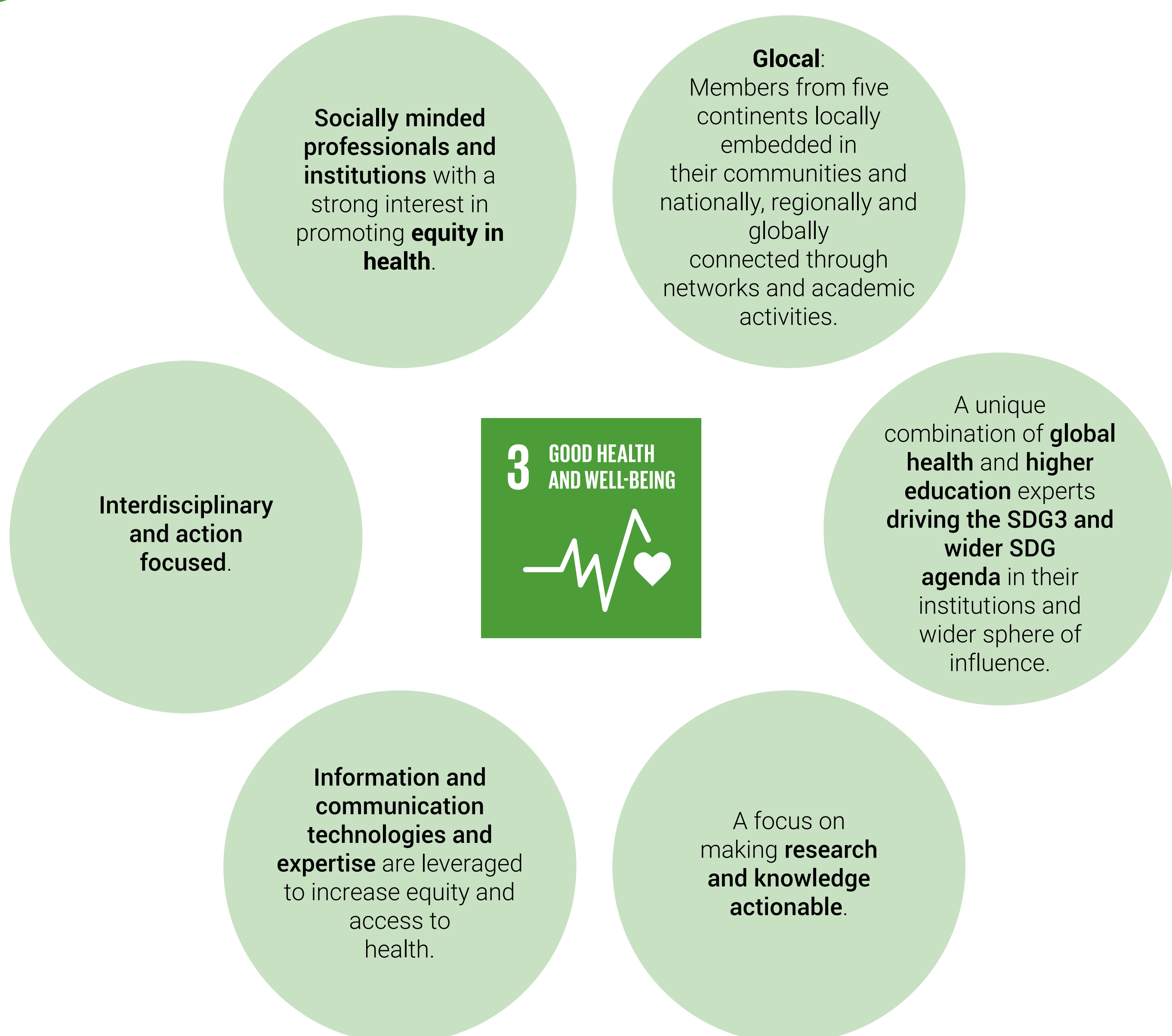
Working towards locally relevant and appropriate solutions, while sharing knowledge globally.
