

Final decision regarding the call for applications for UOC grants for postdoctoral guidance on the doctoral programmes in Society, Technology and Culture; Network and Information Technologies; Education and ICT (E-learning); Humanities and Communication; Health and Psychology, and Law, Politics and Economics – 2024/2025

On 15 the April 2024, the Call for UOC Grant Applications for postdoctoral guidance in the framework of the doctoral programmes in Information and Knowledge Society; Society, Technology and Culture; Network and Information Technologies; Education and ICT (e-learning); Humanities and Communication; Health and Psychology; and Law, Politics and Economics – 2024-2025, was published on the [UOC's e-Noticeboard](#) and the [UOC's Doctoral School website](#), inviting submission of applications between 15 April 2024 and 15 September 2024.
